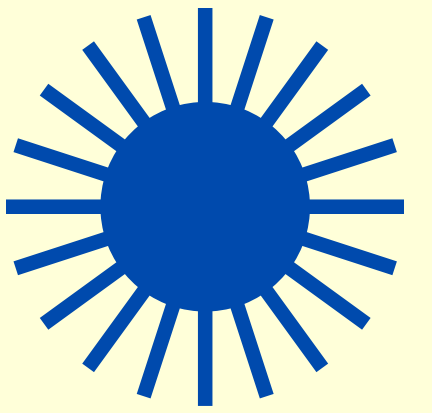

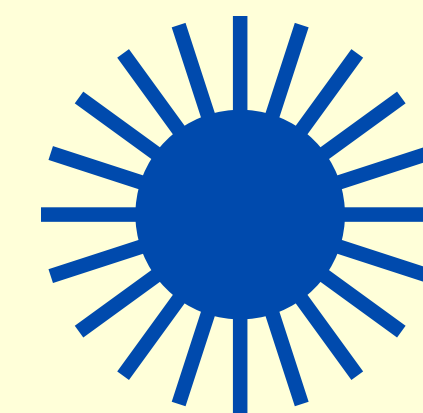
The Lesson Leaders Program is a training program that aims to equip volunteers with the skills needed to teach communities to value the connection between our health and the health of animals, plants, and the environment.

The Process of becoming a Certified Lesson Leaders:

Take a short self-assessment survey focused on your current teaching experience and skills and then sign and date the One Health Lessons Code of Conduct form.

Attend a one-hour orientation session.

Watch a recorded lesson on our YouTube channel and pass its corresponding quiz.

Shadow an experienced Lesson Leader teaching the One Health lesson to a class and evaluating them.

Teach your own One Health class (with a second volunteer buddy to assist).

After teaching, complete a short post-training survey (focused on your teaching experience)

Lastly, receive a certificate acknowledging your training and newly-acquired skills.
